It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 31-22.1-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-22.1 entitled "Pupil
- 2 Transportation Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 31-22.1-1. Pupil transportation vehicle -- Definition.
- 4 A pupil transportation vehicle is a motor vehicle designed and constructed to seat not more
- 5 than eight (8) ten (10) passengers including the operator, used by a school committee to provide
- 6 the transportation services required by law or regulation to students being conveyed along a fixed
- 7 school transportation route. In particular, such vehicles may be used to provide the transportation
- 8 services required by § 16-21-1, § 16-21.1-1, et seq., and § 16-24-4 on routes in which only small
- 9 numbers of students are being conveyed.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES - PUPIL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES

This act would amend the definitions of a "Pupil Transportation Vehicle" to a vehicle

constructed to seat not more than ten (10) passengers including the operator, rather than the existing

limit of eight (8) passengers.

This act would take effect upon passage.
