1 SECTION 1. Section 34-13-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 34-13 entitled "Recording Of Instruments" is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 <u>34-13-7. General recording fees. --</u> (a) The fees to the recording officers for recording 4 the following described instruments relating to real estate shall be as follows: \$80.00 5 Warranty deed Quitclaim deed 80.00 6 7 Deed of executor, administrator, trustee, conservator, receiver, 9 or commissioner 80.00 10 Mortgage 60.00 45.00 11 Partial release of mortgage 12 Assignment of mortgage 45.00 13 Foreclosure deed under power of sale 14 with affidavit 80.00 15 60.00 Lease 16 General assignment 45.00 17 Discharge of mortgage 45.00

14	(d) Notwithstanding the foregoing, the recording fee for recognizance notices, lis	
15	pendens, or liens recorded by bailbondsmen and the recording fee to discharge recognizance	
16	<u>notices</u> , lis pendens, <u>or liens</u> recorded by bailbondsmen shall be ten dollars (\$10.00).	

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
