WINNING THE 2010 DIVISION I RHODE ISLAND HOCKEY STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

1 WHEREAS, The Mount St. Charles Hockey Team defeated LaSalle Academy 5-2 to
2 complete a two-game sweep at Schneider arena and win the state championship, Mount's 41st
3 Rhode Island State Championship and their 29th in the last 33 years; and

4 WHEREAS, Mount St. Charles compiled an extraordinary 21-0-1 undefeated season on
5 the way towards winning the state title. Mount St. Charles was led all season by the best penalty
6 killing team anyone has ever seen at the high school level. Their penalty killing squad of Trevor
7 Plante, Evan Hoffman, Zachary Samborsky, Mike Magerman, and Derek Deschenes didn't give
8 up one shorthanded goal all season, an incredible achievement; and

9 WHEREAS, The Mount team was led all season by the clutch play of Brian Campbell,
10 who scored two goals in the championship winning game and was chosen championship series
11 MVP; the toughness of Team Captain Evan Hoffman; the timely scoring of Jim Golden; the
12 leadership provided by George Hanna and Alex Erban; and the steady goaltending in net
13 produced by Ryan Simoneau. In addition, Mount St. Charles was led by its legendary Head
14 Coach Bill Belisle and his son Dave Belisle; now, therefore be it
