It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-3 of the General Laws entitled "Vital Records" is hereby amended

2 by adding thereto the following section:

3 **23-3-25.2. Incarcerated persons' exemption for fees for copies and searches.**

4 Any incarcerated person who is set to be released from prison to re-enter the community

5 shall be processed without a charge or fee when making a first request for vital statistics at the

6 department of health regarding a request for their own personal records.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
