#### CONGRATULATING REVEREND RICHARD P. DESAULNIERS ON THE OCCASION OF THE 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF HIS ORDINATION

1	WHEREAS, Reverend Richard P. Desaulniers is the oldest of five children born to
2	Robert and Jeanne Desaulniers on June 9 <sup>th</sup> of 1944. He grew up in Woonsocket, attending Mt. St.
3	Francis Elementary School and Precious Blood Junior High School; and
4	WHEREAS, After attaining his diploma from Our Lady of Providence Seminary High
5	School, Father Desaulniers graduated from its college with a Bachelor of Arts degree. He
6	continued his studies at St. Bernard Seminary in Rochester and was granted a Master of Divinity
7	degree in 1969, and completed his theological studies with a Master of Theology degree in 1970;

9	WHEREAS, Ordained to the holy priesthood on May 23 <sup>rd</sup> of 1970 by the Most Reverend
10	Russell J. McVinney, D.D., Father Desaulniers celebrated his first Mass at Precious Blood
11	Church in Woonsocket; and
12	WHEREAS, Originally assigned to St. Jean-Baptiste Church in Pawtucket, Father
13	Desaulniers later served at St. Joseph's Church in Woonsocket, St. Rita's Church in Warwick,
14	and St. Francis of Assisi in Wakefield. He was named Associate Pastor at St. James Church in
15	Manville in 1984, and was appointed as Pastor in 1993. He currently serves as Chaplain of the
16	Manville Fire Department and is a member of the Town of Lincoln's Personnel Board; and
17	WHEREAS, In addition to providing his many parishioners with leadership and spiritual
18	guidance, Father Desaulniers has also proven to be a dynamic force within the community. He
19	joined hands with various civic groups, including serving as a member of the Social Progress

- 1 Action Corporation Board of Directors, as Chaplain and Treasurer of the Woonsocket Jaycees,
- 2 and as Chaplain of the Rhode Island Jaycees; and
- WHEREAS, Father Desaulniers was also Chair of the Woonsocket School Curriculum
  Review Committee; President and Treasurer of the Woonsocket Clergy Association; a board
  member of the Mt. St. Francis Day Care, the Diocesan Grievance Committee, and the Diocesan
  Priests' Council; and Chaplain of the Woonsocket Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS, Father Desaulniers has spent most of his life in devout service to God.
  Through that unification, he has served and blessed the faithful, enriched the spiritual lives of
  many Rhode Islanders, and earned our total respect and admiration for his devotion and his many
  accomplishments; now, therefore be it
