- 4 <u>22-7.4-122. The John J. Wrenn building. The building known as building No. 71, at</u>
- 5 the John O. Pastore Center at 1511 Pontiac Avenue, Cranston, Rhode Island, shall be hereafter
- 6 named and known as the "John J. Wrenn Building".
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
