SENATE RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING CONDOLENCES ON THE PASSING OF WALTER "CHRIS" HEISLER

Introduced By: Senator V. Susan Sosnowski

WHEREAS, It is with great sadness that this Senate has learned of the passing of Walter 1 "Chris" Heisler, a resident and well-respected citizen of the Town of South Kingstown; and 2 3 WHEREAS, In many ways, Chris was a genuine hero. A World War II Veteran of the 82nd Airborne Division/507th Parachute Infantry Regiment, he parachuted onto Normandy Beach, 4 5 France, on June 6, 1944. Four men who jumped with Chris had faulty shoots, and the plane was 6 shot down shortly after the jump. Alone, Chris was determined to find his men. He landed his parachute in a large tree, cut himself loose, and noticed a house 200 yards away. Surrounded by 7 8 Germans, he tried to ambush them, but was trapped and spent time in a prison camp with other 9 WWII soldiers. Eventually, he was released from prison; and 10 WHEREAS, After the war, Chris earned a Master's degree and then a doctoral degree in 11 school administration. He then focused his professional energies on providing an excellent 12 education for aspiring teachers at the University of Rhode Island; and 13 WHEREAS, Chris never forgot or let others forget the supreme sacrifices made by the 14 Greatest Generation. In 2006, he was featured in a documentary about six war veterans returning 15 to Normandy. He felt a responsibility to continue to tell others about what happened on June 6, 16 1944, and the significance of that date. He especially wanted to make sure that those men who 17 didn't make it back had a voice; and 18 WHEREAS, Chris was kind, generous, and infinitely passionate about what he believed 19 in. He touched the lives of generations of young people both through his love of learning and his
