Mr. Evans is a beloved 3 fixture at the State House, widely admired for his vast breadth of knowledge about all things related to Rhode Island civic affairs and Rhode Island history, and deeply appreciated for his 4 5 ability to find an answer to a vexing question in record speed; and WHEREAS, Mr. Evans graduated from Chariho High School in 1982. He graduated from 6 7 the University of Rhode Island with a Bachelor's degree in 1986, and attained a Master's degree in Library Science from the University of Rhode Island in 1987. Shortly thereafter, he began 8 9 working at the State Library for the Rhode Island Secretary of State's Office as a Reference 10 Librarian. In 1990, he was appointed by then-Secretary of State Kathleen Connell to the post of 11 State Librarian; and 12 WHEREAS, From the very beginning of his tenure at the State House, Tom Evans has 13 been a godsend to state legislators, state employees, and the general public, always ready with an 14 answer to a question about Rhode Island government and Rhode Island history, or able to find the 15 answer if extensive research was necessary. Additionally, his always calm demeanor and poised 16 presence was much appreciated by those caught in the throes of the often chaotic nature that is the 17 State House; and 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Evans has also served the State of Rhode Island since 1991, as a board

member of the Consortium of Rhode Island Academic and Research Libraries and the Rhode

1	Island Historical Society, and since 2006, as a Commission member of the Karla Harry
2	Commission on Libraries in Rhode Island. In his free time, Tom is an avid reader, a passionate
3	fan of the Boston Red Sox and the New England Patriots, enjoys travel and photography, and
4	loves doing home improvement projects in his house; and
5	WHEREAS, Mr. Evans' vast knowledge about all things Rhode Island and his tireless
6	work ethic will be sorely missed by all of his colleagues, all staff members working at the State
7	House, all members of the General Assembly, and by the many members of the general public
8	that have come to him over the years looking for, and getting, prompt answers to their questions;
