- 3 WHEREAS, An estimated 150,000 individuals are affected by hereditary and sporadic
- 4 ataxia in the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Ataxia is an often fatal degenerative neurological disorder that affects
- 6 balance, coordination and speech; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Ataxia can strike anyone at any time, without regard to age, gender, race or
- 8 creed; and
- 9 WHEREAS, There is no known cure for Ataxia. The only defense is research and
  10 prevention through education; now, therefore be it
