AMENDMENT 1069A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

An Act to permit the display of campaign signs in municipalities in conjunction with the beginning of absentee voting.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 9-30 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

5 A municipality must allow a campaign sign may to be placed on private property in 6 a residential, business, commercial, or industrial zone adjacent to a transportation right-7 of-way by or with the permission of the property owner beginning-on no later than the 8 day when absentee voting in a primary or general election begins, and may must allow 9 the campaign sign to continue to be displayed through election day. A campaign sign 10 displayed pursuant to this section must be removed within the five seven days following 11 the election. A municipality may regulate the use of campaign signs pursuant to § 9-30-3 12 in any manner that does not conflict with this section or applicable law. 13 For the purposes of this section, the term, campaign sign, means a free-standing 14 object identifying and urging a person to vote for or against a particular ballot question or 15 candidate for public office.
