AMENDMENT 1069F FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

## An Act to permit the display of campaign signs in municipalities in conjunction with the beginning of absentee voting.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

## 4 Section 1. That chapter 9-30 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

5 A municipality must allow a campaign sign may to be placed on private property in 6 a residential, business, commercial, or industrial zone adjacent to a transportation right-7 of-way by or with the permission of the property owner beginning-on no later than ten 8 days prior to the day when absentee voting in a primary or general election begins, and 9 may must allow the campaign sign to continue to be displayed through election day. A 10 campaign sign displayed pursuant to this section must be removed within the five seven 11 days following the election. A municipality may regulate the use of campaign signs 12 pursuant to § 9-30-3 in any manner that does not conflict with this section or applicable 13 law. 14 For the purposes of this section, the term, campaign sign, means a free-standing 15 object identifying and urging a person to vote for or against a particular ballot question or 16 candidate for public office.
