- An Act to to require that all certified educators to take a course in South Dakota
 Indian Studies.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-1-48 be AMENDED:
- 5 **13-1-48.** Any teacher All certified educators new to the profession, or from out-6 of-state, or certified after 1993 shall complete a three-credit-hour course in South Dakota 7 Indian studies. The course shall include components specific to:
- 8 (1) Language and cultural awareness;
- 9 (2) History;
- 10 (3) Educational theory and background of the traditional tribal education; and
- 11 (4) Implementation and strategies of Indian learning styles, curriculum development 12 and authentic assessment.
