1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions of the alcoholic beverages code.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 35-2-6.4 be amended to read:

4 35-2-6.4. ~~Except as provided in § 35-5-3.2, no~~ No manufacturer or wholesaler licensee
5 under this title nor any officer, director, stockholder, agent, or employee thereof or any relative
6 of the licensee, officer, director, stockholder, agent, or employee may be in any way financially
7 interested, either directly or indirectly, or participate in the operation of the business of any
8 retailer licensee other than by reason of sales to the licensee. A retailer who is a party to any
9 action prohibited by this section is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.

10 Section 2. That subdivision (4) of § 35-4-124 be amended to read:

11 (4) A special off-sale package wine dealers license in conjunction with a special event
12 within the municipality or county to any civic, charitable, educational, fraternal, or
13 veterans organization or any licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(3), (5),
14 or (12) or any farm winery licensee in addition to any other licenses held by the
15 special events license applicant. A special off-sale package wine dealers licensee may



1 only sell wine manufactured by a farm winery licensee;
