- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

14 Section 4. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,

15 health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and

16 effect from and after its passage and approval.
