1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the executive director of the Board of Pardons 2 and Paroles to issue a warrant in the event of any escape from extended confinement. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 24-15-14 be amended to read: 5 24-15-14. The Department of Corrections shall exercise supervision over all paroled 6 prisoners, and shall, subject to chapter 3-6A,. The secretary of corrections shall employ or 7 appoint such officers and employees, pursuant to chapter 3-6D, as may be necessary to 8 accomplish the proper supervision of parolees, persons on parole under a suspended sentence, 9 and inmates on work release or house arrest extended confinement pursuant to §§ 24-2-25 and 10 <u>24-2-27</u>. 11 Section 2. That § 24-15-21 be amended to read: 12 24-15-21. If the executive director of the board is satisfied that any provision of § 24-15-20 13 or 24-15A-27 has been violated or an inmate under parole supervision in the community has 14 escaped, the executive director may issue a warrant to the Department of Corrections, any a law

enforcement officer, or any parole agent, directing that the parolee or inmate named be arrested.

- 1 Pursuant to the provisions of § 24-15-23, the parolee may be returned to the state penitentiary.
- 2 Upon the issuance of the warrant, the running of the parole supervision time shall be suspended
- 3 until the board has entered its a final order on the revocation. The board shall credit the inmate
- 4 with time spent in custody as a direct result of the parole violation.
