- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the deposit in the general fund of the
- 2 proceeds from the sale of certain contraband or abandoned items by the Department of
- 3 Game, Fish and Parks.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. That § 41-15-20 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 41-15-20. The secretary of game, fish and parks may sell at the highest market price
- 7 obtainable any fur, fish, game animal, game bird, hunting equipment, fishing equipment, and
- 8 other contraband that is abandoned or is deemed contraband as provided in §§ 41-15-15 to 41-
- 9 15-19, inclusive. The proceeds of the sales shall be turned into the state treasury and credited
- 10 to the Department of Game, Fish and Parks general fund. A record of the sales, including the
- 11 name of the purchaser and the purchase price paid, shall be kept by the secretary. The secretary
- shall, before sale, tag the items to be sold in a manner to be determined by the secretary.
