- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to designate POW/MIA Recognition Day as a working
- 2 holiday.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 1-5 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- The third Friday of September, to be known as POW/MIA Recognition Day, shall be
- 7 observed in this state as a working holiday. POW/MIA Recognition Day is dedicated to the
- 8 remembrance and recognition of the sacrifices endured by those members of the Armed Forces
- 9 of the United States who were held as prisoners of war or remain as missing in action.
