HOUSE STATE AFFAIRS ENGROSSED

An Act to permit the display of campaign signs in municipalities in conjunction with the beginning of absentee voting.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 9-30 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

5	A municipality must allow a campaign sign to be placed on private property in a
6	residential, business, commercial, or industrial zone adjacent to a transportation right-of-
7	way by or with the permission of the property owner beginning no later than ten days
8	prior to the day when absentee voting in a primary or general election begins, and must
9	allow the campaign sign to continue to be displayed through election day. A campaign
10	sign displayed pursuant to this section must be removed within the seven days following
11	the election. A municipality may regulate the use of campaign signs pursuant to § 9-30-3
12	in any manner that does not conflict with this section or applicable law.
13	For the purposes of this section, the term, campaign sign, means a free-standing
14	object identifying and urging a person to vote for or against a particular ballot question or
15	candidate for public office.
