- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- No ballot question committee may accept from any person, organization, political
- 6 committee, or political party that is not a resident of this state contributions that equal more than
- 7 seventy-five percent of the total contributions the ballot question committee accepts from a
- 8 person, organization, political committee, or political party that is a resident of this state.
