1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for limits on certain out-of-state contributions  
2 to ballot question committees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 No ballot question committee may accept from any person, organization, political  
6 committee, or political party that is not a resident of this state contributions that equal more than  
7 seventy-five percent of the total contributions the ballot question committee accepts from a  
8 person, organization, political committee, or political party that is a resident of this state.
