- An Act to establish provisions related to the disclosure of COVID-19 vaccination status and blood donations.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-24B:

Any person who collects human blood donations for the purpose of providing blood for human blood transfusion shall require a blood donor to disclose whether the donor has ever received a COVID-19 vaccination.

If a donor indicates that the donor has received a COVID-19 vaccination, the person collecting the blood donation must label the blood bag to conspicuously indicate that the donor has received a COVID-19 vaccination.

Nothing in this section authorizes the disclosure of the donor's personally identifiable information on the blood bag.

Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-24B:

An individual needing a blood transfusion in a nonemergent situation may request blood based on whether the blood donor received a COVID-19 vaccination. The health care professional performing the transfusion shall use the requested blood, if the blood is available at the health care facility in which the individual is receiving care.
