## HOUSE BILL NO. 1083

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to restrict the term of conservation easements. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 Section 1. Terms used in this Act mean: (1) "Conservation easement," any nonpossessory interest in real property which is 5 executed by or on behalf of the owner of the land and is binding upon successive 6 owners of the land, imposing limitations or affirmative obligations for conservation purposes or to preserve the historical, architectural, archaeological, or cultural aspects 8 of real property; "Conservation purposes," any of the following activities: 9 (2) 10 (a) Preserving land areas for outdoor recreation by, or the education of, the 11 general public; or 12 (b) Protecting a relatively natural habitat of fish, wildlife, or plants or similar 13 ecosystem; or 14 Preserving open space, including farmland and forest land. (c) 15 Section 2. No conservation easement, as defined by section 1 of this Act, created after - 2 - HB 1083

1 July 1, 2014, may be for a period of more than ninety-nine years.
