- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt persons that have not been drinking from charges
- 2 of open container in a motor vehicle.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 35-1-9.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 35-1-9.1. It is a Class 2 misdemeanor for any person occupying a motor vehicle located upon
- 6 a public highway or the right-of-way of a public highway to consume any alcoholic beverage
- 7 or have a package or any receptacle containing an alcoholic beverage in that person's possession
- 8 unless the seal of the original package remains unbroken or the alcoholic beverage is so
- 9 removed from the passenger area of the motor vehicle that no occupant of the motor vehicle has
- 10 access to it. However, no person may be charged pursuant to this section unless the law
- 11 enforcement officer has probable cause to believe that alcohol has been consumed by some
- occupant of the vehicle and a chemical analysis of the occupant's breath or blood discloses there
- is alcohol in the person's body.
