- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish certain provisions regarding conflict of interest
- 2 for legislators.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 A member of the legislative body may not cast a vote on any legislation that the member
- 6 knows or should have known would constitute or create a conflict of interest. For the purposes
- 7 this Act, a conflict of interest involves any action, inaction, or decision by a member in the
- 8 discharge of the member's official duties or matters the member is associated with in an official
- 9 capacity. A conflict exists when a member of a legislative body has substantial financial interest
- by reason of ownership, control, or the exercise of power over any interest greater than five
- 11 percent of the value of any corporation, company, association or firm, partnership,
- proprietorship that is uniquely affected by the proposed legislation.
