- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the minimum age requirements for the
- 2 consumption of alcoholic beverages by certain active duty members of the military.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 35-9 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a licensee under this title, or any
- 6 employee of the licensee, may sell or furnish alcoholic beverages for consumption on the
- 7 premises of a bar or restaurant to a person who:
- 8 (1) Is at least eighteen years old;
- 9 (2) Is an active duty, reserve or National Guard service member of the armed forces of
- the United States; and
- 11 (3) At the time the alcoholic beverage is sold or furnished, displays a valid armed forces
- identification card issued to the person by the United States Department of Defense.
