- 1 An Act to exempt members of Indian tribes in South Dakota from hunting and fishing
 2 license fees.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 41-6 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
- A person who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized Indian tribe located wholly or partially in the state, is exempt from paying any fee regarding the application for, and obtainment of, a license, permit, or stamp classified in § 41-6-10.
