- 2 day decision petitions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-26-9 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-26-9. A decision by a school board to schedule the opening day of classes before the first
- 6 Tuesday following the first Monday in September may be referred to a vote of the qualified
- 7 voters of the school district by the filing of a petition signed by five percent of the registered
- 8 voters in the school district, based upon the total number of registered voters voting at the last
- 9 preceding general election, for districts with more than five thousand registered voters. Petitions
- in districts with less than five thousand registered voters must be signed by five percent of the
- 11 <u>total number of registered voters at the last preceding general election</u>. The board in scheduling
- the opening day of classes shall allow sufficient time for the referendum process authorized in
- 13 this section.
