

2022 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1169

Introduced by: Representative Blare

1 An Act to modify the licensing of barbers.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 36-14-9 be AMENDED:

36-14-9. The Board of Barber Examiners may promulgate reasonable rules,
pursuant to chapter 1-26, for the administration of the provisions of this chapter and to
prescribe sanitary requirements for barbershops and barber schools. A copy of the rules
promulgated by the board shall be furnished by the board to the owner or manager of
each barbershop and barber school. A copy of the rules shall be posted in a conspicuous
place in each barbershop or barber school.

- 10 The Board of Barber Examiners may also promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-11 26, to establish:
- 12 (1) The fee to apply for a certificate of registration for barbers, pursuant to section 3 of
 13 this Act;
- 14 (2) The fee to transfer a barber license or registration to this state, pursuant to § 36 15 <u>14-14;</u>
- 16 (3) The fee for the annual renewal of the certificate of registration for barbers pursuant 17 to §§ 36-14-22 and 36-14-24; and
- 18 (2) The fee for the operation of a barber school or college pursuant to § 36-14-24;
- 19 (3)(4) The fee for the operation of a barbershop pursuant to § 36-14-27; and
- 20 (4) The procedures governing the inspection of barbershops and the barbershop
 21 equipment pursuant to § 36-14-28.

22 Section 2. That § 36-14-13 be AMENDED:

36-14-13. Any person who is at least eighteen years of age and has passed a
 satisfactory examination conducted by the Board of Barber Examiners to determine the

2	license	e or certificate of registration as a registered barber:

8	<u>(4)</u>	Satisfactorily passes the written test and practical barber demonstration certified
