1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit legislation relating to initiated measures for one
2 year after the measure is decided or enacted.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 2-1 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 If a measure is submitted to the voters of the state, legislation may not be proposed to affect
7 the will of the voters for a period of one year after the vote on the measure, or the date of
8 enactment, whichever is later.
