## HOUSE BILL NO. 1176

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to define truancy.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 13-27 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 Any child of compulsory school age who is absent from school without a valid excuse for
- 6 more than three days in any school year is truant.
- 7 Section 2. That § 13-27-11 be amended to read as follows:
- 8 13-27-11. Any person having control of a child of compulsory school age who fails to have
- 9 the child attend school as required by the provisions of this title, is truant as defined in section
- 10 1 of this Act is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor for the first offense. For each subsequent
- offense, a violator of this section is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
- Section 3. That § 13-27-20 be amended to read as follows:
- 13 13-27-20. Each truancy officer shall make and file truancy complaints, and any teacher,
- school officer, or any citizen may make and file a truancy complaint, before a circuit court
- 15 judge, against any person having control of a child of compulsory school age who is not

- 1 attending school or whose attendance is irregular truant as defined in section 1 of this Act. The
- 2 complaint shall state the name of the parent, guardian, or person responsible for the control of
- 3 the child. The complaint shall be verified by oath upon belief of the complainant.
