- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide alternative brand inspection procedures for
- 2 certain rodeo livestock.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 40-20 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 If livestock owned by and bearing the registered brand of a bona fide rodeo producer are
- 7 being transported out of the livestock ownership inspection area by the owner for rodeo
- 8 purposes and there is no change of ownership, the inspection certificate required by § 40-20-4
- 9 may be endorsed, as to the purpose and extent of transportation, by the inspector issuing the
- 10 certificate in order to serve as a travel permit for the livestock described in the certificate. The
- endorsement is effective for the calendar year for which it is issued. The endorsement shall be
- issued by an authorized livestock inspector of the Brand Board. The Brand Board shall
- promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to specify criteria to be used to identify and verify

- 1 ownership of the livestock. The rules shall include a requirement that other means of permanent,
- 2 individual identification of the livestock, including tattoos, number brands, or photographs, be
- 3 provided in addition to the registered brand. The rules shall also establish an annual fee for
- 4 issuance of the endorsement authorized in this section and provide for collection of the fee. The
- 5 fee may not exceed one hundred dollars per year.
