1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide the State-Tribal Relations Committee certain
2 subpoena power.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 2-6-23 be amended to read:

5 2-6-23. The State-Tribal Relations Committee shall continuously study the relationship
6 between the state and its political subdivisions and the tribes and their tribal governments. The
7 committee shall give particular study and consideration to matters concerning jurisdiction,
8 taxation, gaming, economic development and community relations. The committee shall serve
9 as a forum for the discussion of issues of mutual concern to the state and the tribes and shall
10 attempt to foster state-tribal cooperation. The committee shall draw upon public input from all
11 those who may be concerned and knowledgeable about state-tribal relations whether Indian or
12 non-Indian, whether tribal members or nontribal members. In the discharge of the duties
13 imposed by this section, the committee may issue a subpoena to compel the attendance of
14 witnesses or the production of papers, books, accounts, documents, or testimony. The committee



- 1 may present draft legislation and policy recommendations to the Legislative Research Council
- 2 Executive Board to effectuate its mission.
