- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That ARSD 20:14:05:07.02 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 20:14:05:07.02. Educational requirements for state-certified residential appraiser -- General
- 6 education. An applicant for the state-certified residential classification must hold:
- 7 (1) Hold a bachelor's degree, or higher, from an accredited college or university;
- 8 (2) Have a minimum of 120 months and 10,000 hours of appraisal experience; or
- 9 (3) Have served as a county director of equalization for 10 years.
- The college or university must be a degree-granting institution accredited by the
- 11 Commission on Colleges, a regional or national accreditation association, or by an accrediting
- agency that is recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education.
- Section 2. That ARSD 20:14:05:08.01 be amended to read as follows:
- 14 20:14:05:08.01. Educational requirements for state-certified general appraiser -- General
- education. Applicants for the state-certified general appraiser classification must hold:
