1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require lights on certain animal-drawn vehicles while
2 operating on a highway.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 32-17 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 Any animal-drawn vehicle operating on a highway during the period from a half hour after
6 sunset to a half hour before sunrise and at any other time when there is not sufficient light to
7 render the vehicle clearly discernible to any person on the highway at a distance of two hundred
8 feet ahead, shall be equipped with a flashing amber light that is visible from the front of the
9 vehicle and a red flashing light visible from the rear of the vehicle. The red flashing light shall
10 have a minimum diameter of four inches with at least three square inches of surface. A violation
11 of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
