House Bill 1269

- 1 An Act to limit the deployment of the National Guard for federal service.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 33-3 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
- 4 The South Dakota National Guard and any member thereof may not be called into 5 active-duty combat unless the United States Congress has made an official declaration of 6 war or has taken an official action pursuant to Article I, § 8, Clause 15 of the United States 7 Constitution, to explicitly call forth the South Dakota National Guard and any member 8 thereof for the enumerated purposes to execute the laws of the Union, repel an invasion, 9 or suppress an insurrection. The Governor shall take all actions necessary to comply with the requirements of this section. The term, active-duty combat, as used in this section, 10 11 means:
- 12 (1) Participation in an armed conflict;

- 13 (2) Performance of a hazardous service related to an armed conflict in a foreign nation; 14 or
 - (3) Performance of a duty through an instrumentality of war.
