- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide that, upon completion of certain proceedings,
- 2 magistrate judges may return or dispose of property taken in as evidence.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 23A-37-8 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 23A-37-8. The court shall release all property to its rightful owner, if:
- 6 (1) The owner is not prohibited by law from possessing such property;
- 7 (2) The property is not needed as evidence in any judicial proceeding;
- 8 (3) Satisfactory arrangements have been made to return such property to the court if
- 9 subsequently needed as evidence.
- 10 Upon completion of the proceeding, the circuit court or magistrate judge shall make
- arrangements for the return or disposition of all property used as evidence.
