

2025 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 105

1 An Act to establish election day as a legal holiday. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 Section 1. That § 1-5-1 be AMENDED: 4 **1-5-1.** The following are legal holidays in this state: 5 (1)The first day of every week, known as Sunday; the 6 (2) The first day of January, commonly known as New Year's Day; the 7 (3) The third Monday in January, commonly known as Martin Luther King, Jr. Day; the 8 (4) The third Monday in February, the anniversary of the birthdays of Abraham Lincoln 9 and George Washington, commonly known as President's Day; the 10 (5) The last Monday of May, commonly known as Memorial Day; the The nineteenth day of June, commonly known as Juneteenth; the 11 (6) 12 (7) The fourth day of July, commonly known as Independence Day; the 13 (8) The first Monday in September, commonly known as Labor Day; the (9) The second Monday in October, commonly known as Native Americans' Day;-the 14 15 (10)The first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year, 16 commonly known as Election Day; (11)The eleventh day of November, commonly known as Veterans' Day; the 17 (12) The fourth Thursday in November, commonly known as Thanksgiving Day; and the 18 The twenty-fifth day of December, commonly known as Christmas Day; and every 19 (13) 20 (14) Every day appointed by the President of the United States, or by the Governor of 21 this state for a public fast, thanksgiving, or holiday shall be observed in this state 22 as a legal holiday. 23 If the first day of January, the nineteenth day of June, the fourth day of July, the 24 eleventh day of November, or the twenty-fifth day of December falls-upon on a Sunday, 25 the Monday following-is must be observed as a legal holiday-and shall be so observed;
