1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a tuition reimbursement program for certain 2 teachers who teach in rural school districts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read: 5 Terms used in this Act mean: (1) "Eligible teacher," a teacher who teaches in a rural school district, whose first year 6 7 of teaching is after the 2016-2017 school year, who graduated from an accredited 8 postsecondary institution located in South Dakota, and who complies with the 9 provisions of this Act; 10 (2) "Postsecondary tuition and fees," the tuition and generally applicable fees for thirty 11 credit hours per year at a postsecondary institution under the control of the Board of 12 Regents as of July 1, 2017; 13 (3) "Rural school district," a school district located in a community with a population of

ten thousand persons or less.

- 1 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 2 The Department of Education shall establish a tuition reimbursement program for teachers
- 3 to assist rural school districts in recruiting teachers. The department shall select up to twenty
- 4 eligible teachers each year to participate in the tuition reimbursement program.
- 5 Section 3. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Following an eligible teacher's third year of teaching in a rural school district, the teacher
- 7 shall receive reimbursement for four years of postsecondary tuition and fees. The Department
- 8 of Education shall reimburse the teacher from funds appropriated by the Legislature for that
- 9 purpose.
- Section 4. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 11 The Department of Education shall promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to establish
- procedures for eligible teachers to apply for tuition reimbursement, for the selection of eligible
- teachers to participate in the program, and for the distribution of reimbursement funds.
