1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding expenditures incurred
2 during civil proceedings.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 15-17-37 be amended to read:

5 15-17-37. The prevailing party in a civil action or special proceeding may recover
6 expenditures necessarily incurred in gathering and procuring evidence or bringing the matter to
7 trial. ~~Such~~ The expenditures include costs of telephonic hearings, costs of telephoto or fax
8 charges, fees of witnesses, interpreters, translators, officers, printers, service of process, filing,
9 expenses from telephone calls, copying, costs of original and copies of transcripts and reporter's
10 attendance fees, court appointed experts, private investigators, and other similar expenses and
11 charges. These expenditures are termed, "disbursements", and are taxed pursuant to § 15-6-
12 54(d).
