## SENATE BILL NO. 111

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding expenditures incurred
- 2 during civil proceedings.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 15-17-37 be amended to read:
- 5 15-17-37. The prevailing party in a civil action or special proceeding may recover
- 6 expenditures necessarily incurred in gathering and procuring evidence or bringing the matter to
- 7 trial. Such The expenditures include costs of telephonic hearings, costs of telephoto or fax
- 8 charges, fees of witnesses, interpreters, translators, officers, printers, service of process, filing,
- 9 expenses from telephone calls, copying, costs of original and copies of transcripts and reporter's
- attendance fees, court appointed experts, private investigators, and other similar expenses and
- charges. These expenditures are termed, "disbursements", and are taxed pursuant to § 15-6-
- 12 54(d).
