Senate Bill 128

1 **An Act to remove the option to register to vote by a signed statement.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1. That § 12-4-5.4 be AMENDED:**

4 **12-4-5.4.** Any person registering to vote shall provide the person's valid South
5 Dakota driver license number or a South Dakota nondriver identification number on the
6 voter registration form. If a person does not have a valid South Dakota driver license or
7 a South Dakota nondriver identification number, the person shall provide the last four
8 digits of the person's social security number on the voter registration form. ~~If a person~~
9 ~~does not have a valid South Dakota driver license, a South Dakota nondriver identification~~
10 ~~number, or a social security number, the person may only register at the county auditor's~~
11 ~~office and shall sign a statement verifying the fact that the person does not have a valid~~
12 ~~South Dakota driver license, a South Dakota nondriver identification number, or a social~~
13 ~~security number. The statement shall be prescribed by the State Board of Elections.~~
