

## 2025 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 13

## 1 An Act to clarify the effective date of a measure initiated or referred within a political 2 subdivision. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 Section 1. That § 7-18A-14 be AMENDED: 4 5 7-18A-14. No initiated ordinance or resolution is effective unless approved by a 6 majority of the votes cast for and against the ordinance or resolution. If approved, the 7 ordinance or resolution takes effect upon is effective the day following the completion of 8 the canvass of the election returns. 9 Section 2. That § 7-18A-22 be AMENDED: 10 7-18A-22. No referred ordinance or resolution shall become operative is effective 11 unless approved by a majority of the votes cast for and against the same. If approved, it 12 shall take effect upon ordinance or resolution. If approved, the ordinance or resolution is 13 effective the day following the completion of the canvass of the election returns-relating 14 thereto. 15 Section 3. That § 9-20-5 be AMENDED:

9-20-5. No initiated ordinance or resolution <u>shall become operative is effective</u>
unless approved by a majority of the votes cast for and against the <u>same. If so approved</u>,
it shall take effect upon <u>ordinance or resolution</u>. If approved, the ordinance or resolution
is effective the day following the completion of the canvass of the election returns <u>relating</u>
thereto.

## 21 Section 4. That § 9-20-15 be AMENDED:

1	9-20-15. No referred ordinance or resolution-so submitted shall become operative
2	is effective unless approved by a majority of the votes cast for and against the same. If
3	so approved, it shall take effect upon ordinance or resolution. If approved, the ordinance
4	or resolution is effective the day following the completion of the canvass of the election
5	returns-relating thereto.
