- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a rate-setting methodology for services
- 2 delivered by community-based health and human services providers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 The Department of Social Services and the Department of Human Services shall jointly
  - establish a rate-setting methodology for services delivered by community-based health and
- 7 human services providers. Each category of service shall undergo a comprehensive rate
- 8 modeling analysis at least every five years. The departments may elect to conduct the analysis
- 9 earlier or on a more frequent basis if warranted by cost report information or other market
- 10 conditions. Any new service model shall undergo comprehensive rate modeling analysis prior
- 11 to implementation.

- 12 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Rate modeling analysis shall include a review of current cost report data, specific service

delivery and staffing requirements, training and fidelity standards associated with related service

- 2 models, current market factors, and current and impending state and federal policies that may
- 3 impact the cost of service delivery. Any information gathered will be public record.
- 4 Section 3. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Rate modeling analyses shall be an inclusive work group process including providers
- 6 representing each service category under review.
- 7 Section 4. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 8 Rate determination resulting from rate modeling analyses utilizing historical cost report
- 9 information shall be adjusted in a manner to be applied in a prospective fashion subject to
- 10 federal requirements.
- 11 Section 5. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- The department shall report any rate variance to the Governor and to the Legislature on an
- annual basis in conjunction with annual budget hearings.
- 14 Section 6. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 15 This Act applies to all state funded services, including federal funding, Medicaid and block
- grant fund sources, state general funds, and other funds allocated by the Department of Social
- 17 Services or the Department of Human Services, that are provided by the following types of
- 18 community-based providers:
- 19 (1) Nursing facilities;
- 20 (2) Assisted living facilities;
- 21 (3) In-home service providers;
- 22 (4) Group care providers;
- 23 (5) Psychiatric residential treatment facilities;
- 24 (6) Substance abuse disorder treatment and prevention providers;

- 1 (7) Community mental health centers;
- 2 (8) Intermediate care facilities for co-occurring intellectual and developmental

- 5 (10) Other types of providers deemed appropriate for inclusion by either the secretary of
- 6 the Department of Social Services or the secretary of the Department of Human
