- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require health care facilities to allow patients to supply
- 2 their own prescription medications.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 34-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 A patient receiving care at a hospital or other health care facility licensed by the state of
- 7 South Dakota has a right to receive all medication lawfully prescribed to the patient as long as
- 8 the prescription is ordered or approved by the attending physician.
- 9 Section 2. That chapter 34-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 10 follows:
- If a hospital or health care facility cannot provide the medication ordered or approved by the
- 12 attending physician in accordance with the prescription, the patient has a right to supply and self-
- administer the medication. A hospital or health care facility may establish verification,
- inspection, and storage procedures for prescription medication supplied by the patient to ensure

- 1 the health and safety of all patients as long as the procedure does not interfere with a patient's
- 2 right to receive a lawfully prescribed medication.
