## SENATE BILL NO. 162

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit school lunch shaming.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 Regardless of whether or not a student has money to pay for a meal or owes money for
- 5 earlier meals the school shall provide a United States Department of Agriculture reimbursable
- 6 meal to any student who requests one. A school may not require a student throw away a meal
- 7 after it has been served because the student is unable to pay for a meal or owes money for any
- 8 earlier meal. A school may not publicly identify or stigmatize a student by requiring the student
- 9 wear a wristband or handstamp or require a student to do chores or other work to pay for any
- meal. This Act applies to all public and private schools that participate in the national school
- 11 lunch program or school breakfast program.
