1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require a temporary permit to be issued to certain persons
2 lacking certain documents when applying for a driver license or nondriver identification
3 card.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That chapter 32-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
6 follows:

7 If an applicant making application for an operator's license, motorcycle operator's license,
8 restricted minor's permit, motorcycle restricted minor's permit, instruction permit, motorcycle
9 instruction permit, or nondriver identification card does not have the documents required by
10 § 32-12-3.1, 32-12-3.3, 32-12-3.4, or 32-12-3.5, the applicant lives more than fifty miles from
11 a driver exam station, and the applicant would otherwise qualify for the license or permit, the
12 Department of Public Safety shall issue a temporary permit pursuant to § 32-12-19. The
13 temporary permit shall be valid for one year or until the documents are provided and the
14 applicant's license or permit is issued, whichever period is shorter.
