1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions relating to services performed
2 by dental hygienists.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-6A-40 be amended to read as follows:

5 36-6A-40. Any licensed dentist, public institution, or school authority may use the services
6 of a licensed dental hygienist. Such licensed dental hygienist may perform those services which
7 are educational, diagnostic, therapeutic, or preventive in nature and are authorized by the Board
8 of Dentistry, including those additional procedures authorized by subdivision 36-6A-14(10).
9 Such services may not include the establishment of a final diagnosis or treatment plan for a
10 dental patient. Such services shall be performed under supervision of a licensed dentist.

11 As an employee of a public institution or school authority, functioning without the



1 supervision of a licensed dentist, a licensed dental hygienist may only provide educational
2 services.

3 A dental hygienist may perform preventive and therapeutic services under general
4 supervision if all individuals treated are patients of record of a licensed dentist and all care
5 rendered by the hygienist is completed under the definition of patient of record. A dental
6 hygienist may perform preventive and therapeutic services under collaborative supervision if
7 the requirements of § 36-6A-40.1 are met. However, no dental hygienist may perform
8 preventive and therapeutic services under collaborative supervision for more than thirteen
9 months for any person who has not had a complete evaluation by ~~the supervising a dentist,~~
10 unless employed by a nonprofit entity providing services through written agreement with the
11 Indian Health Service or a tribal entity. The exemption for a dental hygienist employed by a
12 nonprofit entity providing services through written agreement with the Indian Health Service
13 or a tribal entity expires on June 30, 2018.
