## SENATE BILL NO. 180

Introduced by: Senators Lederman, Heineman (Phyllis), Jones (Tom), Kirkeby, and Maher  
and Representatives Werner, Cronin, Peterson, Rounds, and Westra

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the increase in the number of video lottery  
2 machines that may placed in a licensed establishment under certain conditions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 42-7A-44 be amended to read as follows:

5 42-7A-44. The placement of video lottery machines in licensed establishments shall be  
6 subject to the rules of the commission promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26. No more than ~~ten~~  
7 fifteen video lottery machines may be placed in any licensed establishment. If more than ten  
8 video lottery machines are placed in a licensed establishment, the number of video lottery  
9 machines that run the South Dakota video lottery terminal communication protocol revision C  
10 & D may not exceed the number of machines that used the protocol in the establishment on  
11 July 1, 2014. The bar or lounge with an on-sale license issued pursuant to subdivision 35-4-  
12 2(12) or (16) shall be restricted to persons twenty-one years of age or older. The entrance to the  
13 area where video lottery machines are located shall display a sign that the premises are restricted  
14 to persons twenty-one years or older. Notwithstanding the restrictions in §§ 35-4-79 to 35-4-  
15 79.2, inclusive, persons under the age of twenty-one may only enter the premises where video



- 1 lottery machines are located provided they are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or spouse of
- 2 twenty-one years or older.
