## SENATE BILL NO. 188

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain groundwater observation wells in the
- 2 event of an oil spill.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 34A-18 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 In the event of an oil spill, a crude oil pipeline operator shall install groundwater observation
- 6 wells. Groundwater observation wells shall be installed at the site of the oil spill and ten miles
- 7 from the site of the spill. The department shall monitor and test any groundwater observation
- 8 well, installed pursuant to this section, for contamination. The department shall monitor and test
- 9 the wells at the time of the spill and sixty days after the spill. The department shall make the
- 10 results of any contamination testing available to the public on the department's website. The oil
- pipeline operator shall pay for the installation of the groundwater observation wells and the cost
- of testing in the event of an oil spill. The department may promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter
- 13 1-26, to establish:
- 14 (1) The minimum requirements for a groundwater observation well;
- 15 (2) The number of ground water observation wells, in addition to the number of wells

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- 1 required by this section, that shall be placed in the event of an oil spill; and
- 2 (3) The location of any ground water observation well, in addition to the location of
- wells required by this section, that is placed in the event of an oil spill.
