SENATE BILL NO. 198

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for a study the issue of creating the Kadoka-
2 Caputa Rails to Hope Trail as a state park.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The Transportation Commission shall conduct a study of advisability and
5 feasibility of establishing a state park, to be known as the Kadoka-Caputa Rails to Hope State
6 Park and consisting of land within the right-of-way of the portion of state-owned rail line
7 between Kadoka and Caputa in Jackson and Pennington counties. The study shall be under the
8 supervision of the commission and staffed by the Department of Transportation and shall
9 include the opportunity for public input. The commission shall submit its recommendations and
10 any draft legislation to the Governor and the Legislature not later than December 15, 2011.
